Measure Challenge

Measure the perimeter of your garden/outdoor area

Newspaper Challenge

Cut letters out of newspapers to make three 9 letter words.

Remember parent can adapt this challenge to make it harder or easier

Grammar Challenge

Write 6 sentences - each sentence must contain a different type of punctuation.

E.g. exclamation mark / question mark

Homophone Challenge

Can you think of 20 homophones. Here are a few to get you started.

Hair/Hare - See/Sea

Cereal Box Challenge

Take an empty cereal box—open the box out and use the inside of it. Children can design their own brand of cereal.—remember to use persuasive language

Spelling Challenge

Parents select 10 words from a book or newspaper that they think their child could spell.

Money Challenge

Mum wants dinner to cost no more than £10. Plan the meal within budget

Angle Challenge

Take photos of three different angles that you can find around your house e.g. right angle, acute and obtuse.

Sport Challenge

Make up your own sports day in the garden.

E.g. Potato and Spoon Race

Garden Challenge

Design your own bug hotel in the garden or outdoor area.
